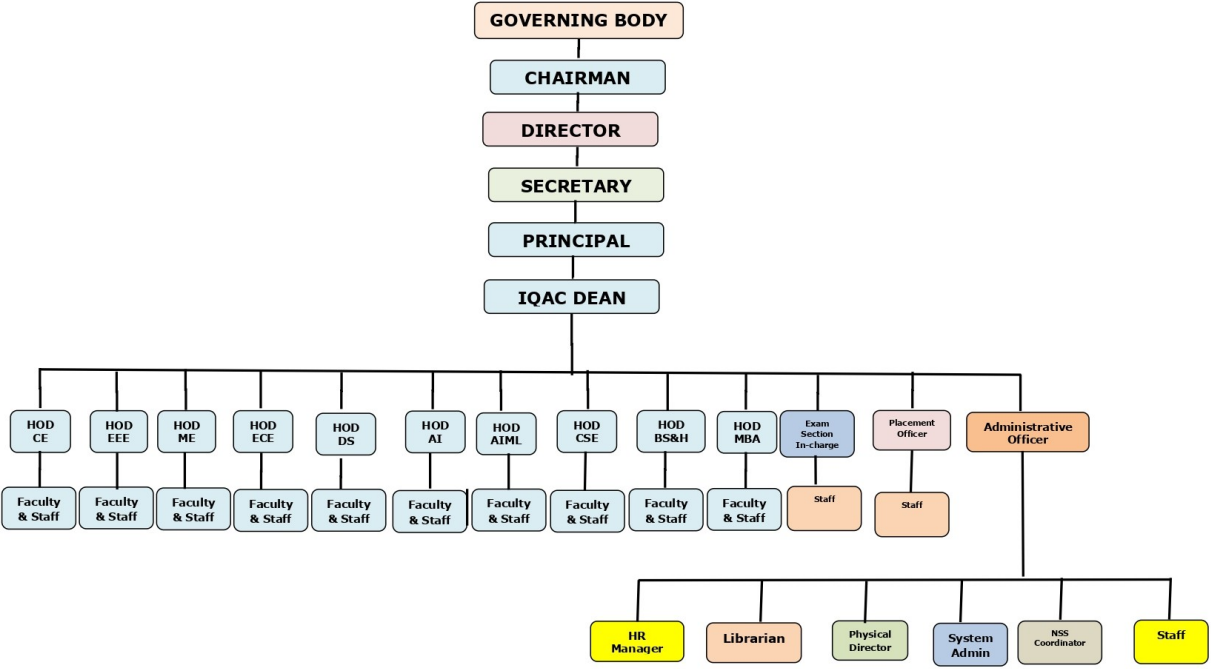

12. To organize the Legal Literacy Camp to create awareness amongst the students, faculty members and parents about the ragging acts and punishments by the legal authorities.
