The members of the Board of Studies appreciated the comprehensive revision of the curriculum under SEAT R26 Regulations and offered the following valuable suggestions for further strengthening the academic quality of the Civil Engineering programme:

1. The Board appreciated the incorporation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools and Python-based computational exercises in the curriculum and suggested that adequate hands-on training sessions be organized to familiarize students with the recommended open-source software and digital platforms.
2. The members recommended encouraging students to undertake multidisciplinary mini-projects and problem-based learning activities that address real-world civil engineering challenges using emerging technologies such as Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, and Building Information Modelling (BIM).
3. It was suggested that greater emphasis be given to industry interaction through expert lectures, industrial visits, internships, and collaborative activities with industry professionals to bridge the gap between academic learning and professional practice.
4. The Board recommended periodic revision of the prescribed textbooks, reference books, web resources, and AI-enabled learning tools to ensure that the curriculum remains aligned with the latest technological advancements and industry requirements.
5. The members advised strengthening laboratory components by incorporating more application-oriented experiments, simulation-based learning, and computational analysis using free and open-source engineering software.
6. The Board appreciated the subject-wise panels of Question Paper Setters and External Evaluators and recommended that experts from premier institutions such as IITs, NITs, Central Universities, and reputed autonomous institutions continue to be included while revising the panels in future.



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Resolution

The Chairman thanked the members for their valuable suggestions and constructive recommendations. The Board resolved that the above suggestions would be duly examined and incorporated, wherever applicable, during the implementation and future revision of the SEAT R26 Regulations. Thereafter, the Board unanimously approved the B.Tech I Year (I & II Semester) Course Structure and Detailed Syllabus under SEAT R26 Regulations, along with the panels of Question Paper Setters and External Evaluators for the Department of Civil Engineering.

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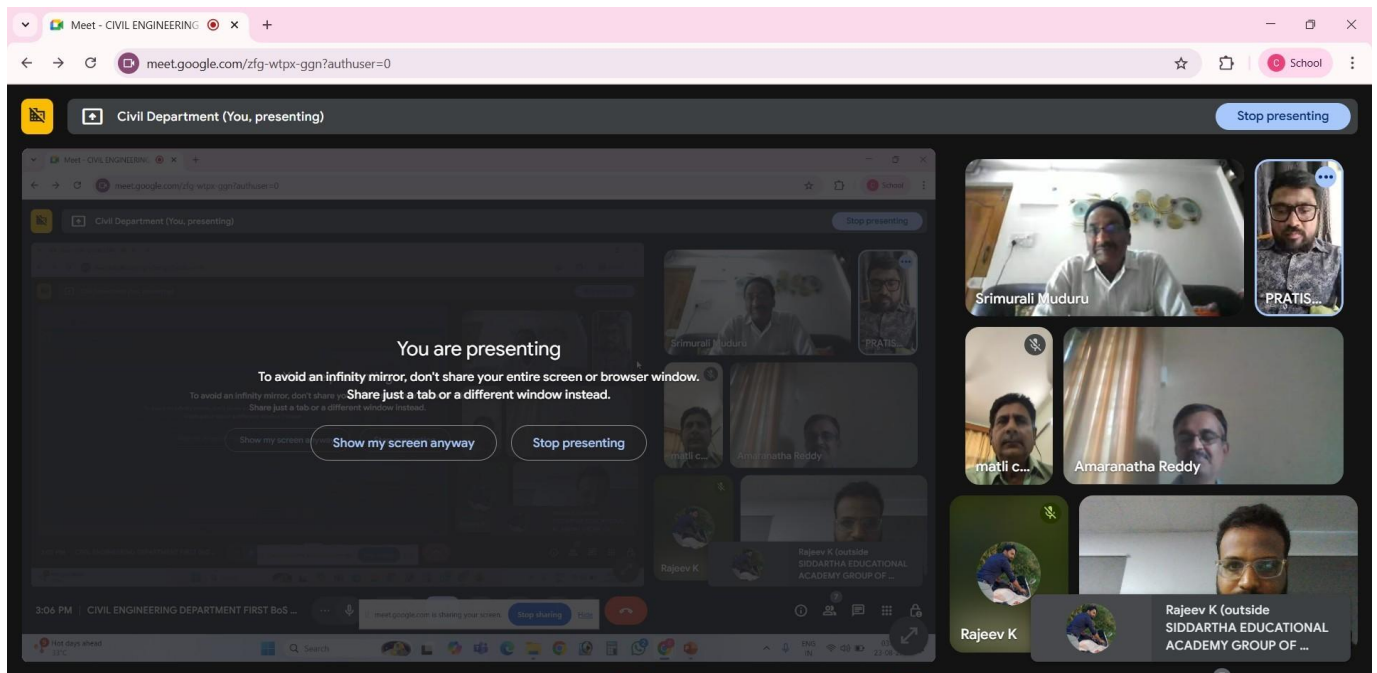
